

Australia Post Cash Passport Survey Promotion – Terms and Conditions

- 1.1. Information on prizes and how to enter form part of these conditions of entry.
- 1.2. This is a game of skill. Each entry will be judged on creativity and content. Based on these criteria a panel of judges will deem the most interesting and inspiring entries.
2. The Promoter is Australian Postal Corporation (ABN 28 864 970 579) trading as “Australia Post” of 111 Bourke St, Melbourne VIC 3000.
3. The promotion commences at 9am AEDT on Monday 16th January 2017 and entries need to be submitted to the Promoter by 5pm AEDT on Friday 10 February 2017. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for lost, late, illegible or misdirected entries.
4. Entry is open to all residents of Australia who fulfil the entry requirements. Entrants must be at least 18 years old. Employees, directors, management, licensees and contractors of the Promoter, its related companies and agencies associated with the promotion, the immediate families of the above listed persons, and the retailers of and suppliers to the Promoter are ineligible to enter.
5. To enter the promotion, entrants must complete the Australia Post Cash Passport Survey and complete a valid entry form at the end of the survey online by 5pm AEDT on Friday 10 February 2017. The entry form requires entrants to complete the survey, accept the terms and conditions of the Australia Post Small Business Survey Promotion, confirm their registration and answer the following question “In 100 words or less, tell us why you chose your Cash Passport?”
6. There is a limit of one entry per person.
7. Each entrant warrants that all details provided in their entry form are true and correct and that the entry is their own original creation and work, and does not infringe the rights (including copyright) of any other person. Each entrant agrees to indemnify the Promoter in relation to any loss or damage resulting from any breach of warranty.
8. The prize winners will be the five entrants whose entries provide the best answer to the question (in paragraph 5) in the opinion of the Promoter’s panel of judges. Prize winners will each win a \$200 Coles Myer Gift voucher. Each Prize is worth \$200.00 and the total prize pool is valued at \$1,000.00.
9. Judging will take place on Tuesday 14 February 2017 at Australia Post at 11am AEDT, 15/111 Bourke Street, Melbourne VIC 3000. The winners will be notified by email and the winners’ name and state will be published on <http://auspost.catagraph.com.au/1122winners.html> on Thursday 16 February 2017.

If prize(s) remain unclaimed 4 weeks after the winner s are determined, the Promoter may award the prize to another entrant whose entry is the next best in the opinion of the Promoter’s panel of judges. If necessary, judging for the unclaimed prize(s) will be conducted on Tuesday 14 March 2017 at 11am, 15/111 Bourke Street, Melbourne, VIC 3000. The winners will be notified by email and the winners’ name and state will be published on <http://auspost.catagraph.com.au/1122winners.html> on Thursday 16 March 2017
11. The Promoter’s decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and are not redeemable for cash. All entries become the property of the Promoter.
12. To the extent permitted by law, each entrant hereby assigns to the Promoter all intellectual property rights (including copyright) in the entry submitted. If any intellectual property rights (including a moral right) cannot be assigned, each entrant hereby grants to the Promoter an irrevocable exclusive licence in perpetuity to use, copy, distribute, broadcast, modify, adapt and otherwise exploit the entry for any purpose, together with all ancillary rights. The Promoter may exercise all such rights without any fee being paid to the entrant.

The Promoter, its contractors, employees and agents shall not be liable for any claims, losses, damages, injuries, costs and expenses suffered sustained or incurred (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) as a result of, arising out of or in any way connected with the promotion and / or its prizes, except for liability that cannot be excluded by law. The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone, network or lines, computer online systems, servers or providers, computer equipment, software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the internet or at any website, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to entrant's or referral's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation in or downloading any material in this promotion.

If there is an event beyond the Promoter's reasonable control which prevents or hinders the conduct of the promotion or the Promoter's ability to deliver the prize to the winner, then the Promoter may in its discretion cancel the promotion. Further, the Promoter may at its sole discretion recommence it under the same conditions.

16. Entry into the promotion shall be deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry and is deemed approval to use the winners' name(s) and photograph(s) for publicity purposes. The Promoter may at its discretion refuse to award any prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these conditions of entry.
